We have started to use the Knowstone Facebook (FB) page for advertising and sharing posts across similar local FB pages. We also now have a dedicated person looking after the communications and advertising.

Hall maintenance has become an important discussion topic. We have identified that there is problem with the stone wall at the front and are currently in process of investigating the best course of action. It is likely to require a structural engineer to assess and possibly a significant investment to rectify. We are planning to apply for the Platinum Jubilee Village Hall Improvement Grant to fund this. The maintenance team have already sorted out the gas tank issue and we now have new pipe from the tank to the hall. They have also replaced lights with more energy efficient one. We are also looking to improve our kitchen facilities to bring them to a modern standard.
